India Renal Foundation (IRF) is a voluntary not-for-profit health organization working for Prevention, Treatment, Rehabilitation, Education and Research in the area of kidney diseases in Gujarat since January 2002.

Public Awareness Programs are the core activities of the organization, whichis currently on going in the villages of Gujarat. Kidney Failure is a traumaticand fatal disease; thus, it is our responsibility to educate the society on theimportance of having healthy kidneys for a healthy life. We know kidneydisease can be easily detected with blood pressure, blood sugar and kidneytest. Timely diagnosis and treatment can prevent the progression of incurabledisease such as Chronic Renal Failure (CRF). Therefore, it is need of the hourto make society aware about renal problems and its serious emergingcomplications.

India Renal Foundation has done various activities in the last 3 months of October to December under the main program of the organization. The details of which are as follows:

1. PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME and kidney (Serum Creatinine) diabetes and blood pressure screening camp

During this quarter (October to December 2023), we organised 88 awareness programs and 54 screening camps were held across Gujarat, with people being made attentive through these programs in various talukas and interior villages of Vadodara, Surat, Anand, Narmda, Mehsana, Rajkot, Bhavnagar, Gandhinagar, Himmatnagar and Ahmedabad district. Around 2900 people were given proper advice about diabetes – BP and to prevent kidney disease.

2. PRERANA:

Prerna is a rehabilitation program run by IRF since October 2002. The motive is to improve emotional stability and quality of life of kidney patients.

Our care goes beyond dialysis. We strongly believe in comprehensive care through psychosocial and emotional support, which is important for patients' rehabilitation. This is especially needed when patients are first diagnosed with kidney failure as it is a traumatizing experience. Many are unable to come to terms with their illness and some lose the will to live.

4. Save a Life Programme:

'Save a Life' is India Renal Foundation's endeavor to provide financial assistance to needy patientsundergoing dialysis and kidney transplant. This activity was started in July 2002.

During this quarter (October to December) we helped Rs. 2,08,351/- supporting 47 needy dialysis patients and kidney transplant patients by the way of providing dialysis kits, medicines, and support for the surgery expenses of making A.V. Fistula.

In past 3 months we helped 1needy kidney patient for AV Fistula surgery.

Sitaben Lalabhai Vaghri

Sitaben Lalabhai Vaghri lives in Mehsana. Who was undergoing kidney treatment at Nutan Hospital in Visnagar. Due to increasing kidney problems, Dr. J.N. Referred to Dr. Neil Patel (Nephrologist) by Zaveri (Rotary Club Visnagar). Sitaben had been suffering from high blood pressure for a long time and the report revealed that the creatine levels were elevated. Doctor informed her that she was suffering from chronic renal failure and advised her to start dialysis. Due to her poor financial condition, they could not afford Fistula surgery. Dr.Neil Patel made contact of IRF with Sitaben and she was interviewed by IRF officials. Sitaben has four children between the ages of 10 and 15. She and her husband ran the household as casual laborers, as their financial condition is not good and cannot afford the surgery, India Renal Foundation Mehsana helped for the complete fistula surgery and their operation was completed successfully. Sitaben Lalabhai Vaghrithanked a lot to IRF.

Patients, staff tell their stories

'Shining the Light of Hope – The Healing Touch', a book by TANKER Foundation inspired by Founder Trustee, Dr Georgi Abraham, was released by Greater Chennai Corporation Commissioner, Dr. J. Radhakrishnan, at a glittering function in November 2023.
