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
Campaign overview

Marked on March 14, 2024, the World Kidney Day (WKD) campaign focused on "Kidney Health for All: Advancing equitable access to care and optimal medication practice" and stressed the importance of ensuring equitable access to appropriate treatment and care for people living with kidney disease, in order to improve their quality of life and delay the progression of the disease.
