





India Renal Foundation (IRF) is a voluntary not-for-profit health organization working for Prevention, Treatment, Rehabilitation, Education and Research in the area of kidney diseases in Gujarat since January 2002.

Today IRF is in its 22nd year and has 9 chapters in the state of Gujarat functioning at Ahmadabad, Mehsana, Vadodara, Surat, Bhavnagar, Rajkot Kutch-Bhuj, Geer-Somnath and Himmatnagar and have prominent citizens as advisory committee members at all chapters.

1. PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME and kidney (Serum Creatinine) diabetes and blood pressure screening camp

Our organizations' core activity is to create awareness on kidney and kidney disease among society and peoples. We have many major programmes but the First and foremost is PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME. Through this programme we spread awareness about kidney and Kidney diseases by power point presentation. We conduct the PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME in corporate, banks, residential complexes, voluntary organizations, social service club, school/ colleges, associations, etc.

During this quarter (July to September 2024), we organised 102 awareness programs and 47 screening camps were held across Gujarat, with people being made attentive through these programs in various Taluka and interior villages.

"A Mountain of Kidney Health": together with the Italian Kidney Foundation to understand, prevent and detect early Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD)

Last September 29th, the Italian Kidney Foundation (FIR) dedicated an entire day to the knowledge, prevention and early treatment/detection of CKD. The event took place in the main square of Leonessa, a small medieval mountain village in central Italy. Professor Alessandro Balducci, President-elect 2024-26 of the International Federation of Kidney Foundations - World Kidney Alliance (IFKF-WKA), also attended the event.

The participants - about 200 people, mostly from the nearby Italian regions of Lazio, Marche, Umbria and Abruzzo - met in Piazza 7 Aprile at 10 am, awaiting the arrival of the group that reached Leonessa from Rome through an awareness motorcycle race.

The motorcycle group was previously warmly welcomed at the San Camillo De Lellis Hospital in Rieti, before continuing the journey along the panoramic road of Monte Terminillo.

During the morning people took part in a very interesting cultural visit to the historic center and joined the free nephrological screening: Nephrologists and nurses carried out urine tests and blood pressure measurement, giving a referral to a Nephrologist to patients who tested positive.

In the square it was also possible to freely access the Health Village, a space that hosted various information points dedicated to:

- Lifestyles to prevent CKD and hypertension;
- Treatment of CKD;
- Correct nutrition;
- Importance of organ donation for kidney transplantation.

Later, people visited the Convent of the Capuchin Friars, where the participants had the opportunity to live an experience of peace and reflection. The visit was also enriched by small surprises, including the donkeys, which added a further touch of uniqueness to the day.

This event was able to combine health prevention, local culture and valorization of the territory, demonstrating how it is possible to combine physical well-being, and naturally renal well-being, with cultural enrichment and conviviality.

WORLD SUGAR CONSUMPTION REDUCTION WEEK

BE CAREFUL ABOUT SUGAR ADDICTION

The Turkish Kidney Foundation, which has been drawing attention to the importance of the subject with events for three years for the 'World Sugar Consumption Reduction Week', took to the field this year as the institution that developed and implemented this special week. TBV visited the retirees club with its experts and volunteer supporters, and served both retirees and the public unsweetened Turkish coffee accompanied by information on the subject, and drew attention to sugar consumption and hidden sugar.

World Sugar Consumption Reduction Week event was held at the Beyoğlu Municipality's retirees club. At the event, theater actor and foundation volunteer Miss Eylem Şenkal served unsweetened Turkish coffee to the public together with foundation president Timur Erk. Speaking about the importance of the day, TBV President Timur Erk drew attention to hidden sources of sugar and stated that excessive sugar consumption forms the basis of many diseases, primarily kidney disease. TBV President Erk; "Sugar means addiction, Turkey must reduce sugar consumption. All institutions, especially our people, have great responsibilities in this regard. Just as we reduced salt consumption, we urgently need to reduce sugar consumption as well," he said. "



THERE WILL BE NO DEFICIENCY IF SUGAR IS NOT EATEN UNTIL YOU DIE"

Providing information about 'World Sugar Consumption Reduction Week', Istanbul University Endocrinology and Metabolism Department Faculty Member Prof. Dr. Kubilay Karşıdağ, MD drew attention to the fact that a high proportion of the population has diabetes in his speech. Prof. Dr. Karşıdağ: "15 percent of people in Turkiye have diabetes, 15 percent also have latent diabetes. When we look at it, almost 15 percent of the social security institution's spending is spent on diabetes alone, and these are very high figures. There is another concept, and that is being overweight. One third of the people in Turkiye are overweight. These are extraordinarily high figures. After a while, we will start to be unable to cope with the problems it causes. One of the most important things we need to do is to try to prevent this. The best way is to try to avoid sugar, hidden sugar and being overweight. In other words, if I do not eat table sugar from 0 to 100 years old, I will not have any deficiencies. Table sugar is not like fruit, water, milk, meat, cheese, if we do not eat these, we will have deficiencies, but if we do not eat table sugar, we will not have any deficiencies," he said.

THINGS TO STAY AWAY FROM IN DIET

Prof. Dr. Kubilay Karşıdağ, drawing attention to the fact that sugar should be eliminated: "First of all, we should eliminate sugar. Please do not confuse this with the sugar in fruit. These are different concepts. We should definitely eat about three handfuls of fruit every day. The measure here is everyone's own palm. But we should stay away from desserts like baklava or anything made with fructose. To put it very simply, for nutrition. We say stay away from 5 things:

- 1. sugar and sugary foods, here the criterion is if sugar is added to a food while it is being prepared, stay away from it.
- 2. stay away from white bread,
- 3. stay away from rice pilaf,
- 4. especially stay away from soft drinks with added sugar or fructose.
- 5. stay away from products made outside as much as possible, that's all.



Other than that, be careful about what you eat and drink. There is another thing above all, no matter what you do every day, definitely walk. We should walk between 20 and 60 minutes according to our age and capacity. This is extremely important for the development of muscles when we are young and for the muscles not to become weak in older ages. There are risks waiting for us in older ages. Treatment is possible, but prevention would be a more appropriate approach.

Briefly, you can be careful and protect yourself from many diseases, especially diaetes, cancer and arthritis, which are related to this, by simply not eating sugar." he said.

This year, the 19-25 September 'World Sugar Consumption Reduction Week', which is being discussed for the third time, is being brought to the agenda throughout the country with different activities of Governorships, Provincial Health Directorates, Provincial National Education Directorates. This special week is also gaining strength with the participation of countries that are members of the International Kidney Foundation Federation.


