

Events Marking World Kidney Day 2025 in Bosnia and Herzegovina

The commemoration of this important day, significant both for professionals and the general public, started a bit earlier this year.

A professional gathering at the "Abdulah Nakaš" General Hospital in Sarajevo was the first event organized to mark the occasion. It was organized by the Donor Network in BiH and the Association of Dialyzed and Transplanted Patients of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, with excellent hosting by the hospital's management.

The event took place on February 27, 2025, with a large number of hospital staff in attendance. They had the opportunity to listen to expert presentations on the prevention of kidney disease, as well as the treatment of the disease through dialysis and transplantation.

At the end of the presentations by distinguished professors and doctors from the Sarajevo General Hospital and the Clinical Center of the University of Sarajevo, an emotional documentary titled "Life After" was shown.

Everyone who wished to was given the opportunity to sign donor cards.

This professional gathering was also supported by the Federal Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Civil Affairs of BiH.

The central event marking World Kidney Day was held at the University Clinical Center Tuzla, on the actual World Kidney Day, Thursday, March 13, 2025, in attendance were a large number of patients, healthcare professionals, medical students, young doctors, and the Minister of Health of Tuzla Canton.

The event attracted significant media coverage and was organized by the Association of Dialyzed and Transplanted Patients of FBiH, the Donor Network in BiH, and UKC Tuzla.

This was another opportunity to review the situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina regarding the current state of healthcare related to kidney disease, dialysis, and transplantation, using statistical data that highlights the rising number of patients and warns of the need for even greater efforts in prevention of this serious and insidious disease.

Particular interest was sparked by a lecture from Professor Andrej Škoberne from the University of Ljubljana, who presented on kidney disease treatment and transplantation in Slovenia, and shared Slovenia's experiences and importance of membership in EUROTRANSPLANT.

World Kidney Day was also marked in two high schools in Central Bosnia Canton, organized by the Association of Dialyzed and Transplanted Patients SBK/KSB and the Donor Network in BiH, in agreement with school directors. In Kiseljak High School, and a few days later in Travnik High School, a short educational lecture was held for about 70 students.

The lectures focused exclusively on kidney disease prevention, its symptoms, and the fascinating role of the kidney as an organ.



A short three-minute educational film called "Strong Kidneys" was shown, and the session ended with a quiz titled "How Well Do You Know Your Kidneys?".

After the lectures, each participant received an educational brochure with the "8 Golden Rules," a themed badge, a bottle of natural water, and an apple as symbols of a healthy lifestyle.

Executive Board 156th session

EB156/CONF./6

3 February 2025

Reducing the burden of noncommunicable diseases through promotion of kidney health and strengthening prevention and control of kidney disease

Draft decision proposed by Armenia, Burkina Faso, Chile, Ecuador, Georgia, Guatemala, Malaysia, Mexico, Micronesia (Federated States of), Nauru, Panama, Romania, Somalia, Spain, Thailand, Ukraine and Vanuatu

The Executive Board, having considered the report by the Director-General,1

Decided to recommend to the Seventy-eighth World Health Assembly the adoption of the following resolution:

The Seventy-eighth World Health Assembly,

(PP1) Having considered the report by the Director-General;

(PP2) Recognizing the right of every human being, without distinction of any kind, to the enjoyment of the highest attainable standard of physical and mental health;

(PP3) Reaffirming our collective commitment to reduce premature mortality from noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) by one-third, and achieving the targets in the WHO global action plan for the prevention and control of NCDs 2013–2030 (WHASE 10 (2013) and WHA72(11) (2019)) as committed to in the Political Declarations of the three High-Level Meetings of the General Assembly on the Prevention and Control of NCDs (A/RES/66/2; A/RES/68/300; A/RES/73/2), including the nine voluntary global targets to prevent and control NCDs to be achieved by 2025, through effective health promotion and diseases prevention, resilient health systems, an adequate, well trained and committed health workforce, universal health coverage (UHC) and people-centred health services as well as the need to promote access and maintain essential NCD services in emergencies and humanitarian settings (A/RES/78/4);
















India Renal Foundation



India Renal Foundation (IRF) is a voluntary not-for-profit health organization working for Prevention, Treatment, Rehabilitation, Education and Research in the area of kidney diseases in Gujarat since January 2002.

Today IRF is in its 23rd year and has 9 chapters in the state of Gujarat functioning at Ahmadabad, Mehsana, Vadodara, Surat, Bhavnagar, Rajkot, Kutch-Bhuj, Geer-Somnath and Himmatnagar and have prominent citizens as advisory committee members at all chapters.

PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME and kidney (Serum Creatinine) diabetes and blood pressure screening camp

Our organizations' core activity is to create awareness on kidney and kidney disease among society and peoples. We have many major programmes but the First and foremost are PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME. Through this programme we spread awareness about kidney and Kidney diseases by power point presentation. We conduct the PREVENTION THROUGH AWARENESS PROGRAMME in corporate, banks, residential complexes, voluntary organizations, social service club, school/ colleges, associations, etc.

During this quarter (January to March 2025), we organised 108 awareness programs and 46 screening camps were held across Gujarat, with people being made attentive through these programs in various Taluka and interior villages.



3. Save a Life

'Save a Life' is India Renal Foundation's endeavor to provide financial assistance to needy patients undergoing dialysis and kidney transplant. This activity was started in July 2002.

During this quarter (January to March) we helped Rs. 1,76,917/- supporting 36 needy dialysis patients and kidney transplant patients by the way of providing dialyzer and Blood tubing, medicines, and support for the surgery expenses of making A.V. Fistula.

Payal More

My name is Payal Morey and I am a 27 year old woman from Vapi Gujarat, but I am living in Vadodara for my Renal Replacement Therapy. I have completed my studies in MBA - HR.

My health has taken a challenging turn in my life. This problem started in the year 2020 when I lost my father due to his medical condition and with his death, our family's only source of income also stopped.

For the last seven years, I have been suffering from chronic kidney disease and am undergoing dialysis treatment under the supervision of Dr. Kamlesh Parikh, a renowned Nephrologist from the city of Vadodara.



Unfortunately, due to my health related issues, it has become difficult for me to get employment, due to which our financial situation has become even worse and it has become difficult for me to take this treatment.

During that time, a one-day trip organized by the India Renal Foundation under the 'Prerana' program at Jarod, I met an official of the organization where I told them about my problems. After that, the organization started helping me financially considering my problem, which gave me a lot of relief. Now I regularly attend every Prerana program organized by the IRF.



Musical program organized to help in the treatment of needy kidney patients

Shri Rohitbhai Parikh, a member of the local advisory committee of the Vadodara chapter of the organization, has taken a resolution to raise funds to financially help kidney patients in their treatment by organizing 71 musical programs on the occasion of his 71st Birthday.

In accordance with which, 2 musical programs were organized during this period.

The first program was organized on January 20, 2025 at 5 pm for Anandalaya Senior Citizens Association (Natubhai Center, Gotri). In this program, old film songs were sung by Shri Rohitbhai Parikh and the artists of his musical group. In which the organization received a donation of Rs. 12,000/- for the Save a Life program.







Another program was organized on March 21, 2025, at Kalyan Prasad Hall, Mandvi Road, Vadodara. 


Activities of note

Porte Aperte in Nefrologia is a project through which workstations are set up in hospitals that decide to participate. There, doctors and nurses are available to citizens in order to provide information on the prevention of kidney disease and to run free urine tests and blood pressure measurements with immediate report delivery. If necessary

pressure measurements with immediate report delivery. If necessary, they can also activate a subsequent clinical study program.

Free screening tests held in cities squares for the general population, especially for those belonging to groups with little access to coded diagnostic-therapeutic paths in order to bring out the undeclared diagnosis for timely therapies that significantly improve the quality of life of patients with CKD.





Activities of note

in Nephrology as well as nurses explainwhat a kidney failure is, how it can be treated and


how couldbe prevented. At these meetings, students are subjected to blood pressure measurement and urine stick screening.










World Kidney Day – ALE Association, March 2025

On March 12, ALE Association, I.A.P., commemorated World Kidney Day with a national event focused on raising awareness of the importance of kidney health in Mexico. 


We have carried out both online and face-to-face training activities within the scope of World Kidney Day events.
